This deed made this 28th day of October Eighteen hundred and seventy by Jacob Warnefelts of Frederick County State of Maryland, Widewideth, that in consideration of One thousand and fifty dollars the said Jacob Warnefelts doth grant unto Harriet Weaver of the said County, all the following described Lot of Ground situated in Frederick County aforesaid and in the village of Myerenville, being part of a tract of land, called New Layony part of John Jones Holly, Beginning for the outlines of the lot thereby intended to be conveyed at a planted stone standing at the end of the 3^d line in the deed from Jonathan Baker and wife to Lewis Housen dated on the twenty third day of October Eighteen hundred and fifty eight and Recorded in Liber B. G. N. No. 2 Folio 640, One of the Land Records of Frederick County aforesaid, and running thence North seven degrees East three perches, South Eighty degrees West twelve perches to the middle of the street; then along the middle of the street, South seven West three perches to the North West corner of the Parsonage grounds, belonging to the United Brethren Church; then along said grounds North Eighty degree West twelve perches to the beginning, Containing Thirty six square perches of Land, more or less, in fee simple.
