This Deed, made this Twenty first day of September, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty three Vallactta S T Weagly, Executor of the last Will & Testament of James R Weagly late of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, deceased Witnesseth, that in consideration of a power in said Will contained, and the further consideration of Nine thousand seven hundred and eighty two dollars and forty five cents, the said Vallactta S T Weagly Executor, as aforesaid doth grant unto William H Ramsburg, all that tract parts of tracts, and parcels of Land situate lying and being in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, as laid down on the Plat of the lands of late Valentine Adams deceased by William H Helleary Surveyor of Frederick County in April 1860 the same being the Southern division thereof, comprising part of a tract, called "Keepers Prospect" and part of "The Reserve on Locust Level," beginning for the same, at a stake standing on the West side of the County Road leading to "Keepers Hill, at the end of the 10th line of "Keepers Prospect" it being the beginning of the 112, 0, 07, conveyed to the late Valentine Adams by Jacob and Michael Keepers trustees, then by and with the outlines thereof the ten following courses, correcting for variation, South 14 1/2° East 15 1/2 perches running down said Road South 20° West 23 1/2 perches, still down the Road then leaving Road South 64 1/2° East 7 1/2 perches to a stone planted, South 24 1/2° East 4 2 3/4 perches to a stake in the edge of the creek, South 24 3/4° West 26 1/2 perches to a white marble stone inscribed V Adams, South 61° 6' East 50 1/4 perches, South 82 1/2° East 40 1/4 perches to a stake at the end of 26 1/2 perches on the 5th line of "Keepers Prospect," and with
