Crum, in consideration of my confidence in her prudence, and Judgment, and justice, all of my real, and personal property of which I am possessed at this time, consisting of my present home in Johnsville, containing about one acre of Land with all the improvements thereon, together with all my private property, household goods, with all other property, I may have on hand, at the time of my death, the same to be for her sole, and exclusive use, during her natural life, and at her death I wish her dear son James H. Crum, to have it, all. I do hereby constitute, and appoint my affectionate niece, Ellen S. Crum, to be sole executrix of this my last Will and testament, reserving, and annulling all former wills by me made, ratifying and confirming, this and no other to be my last will, and testament.
