3d Sub: - She did. I look at Exhibit No. 1 - now here shown me It does.

4th Sub: - She left no husband, but left children and Grand children, as follows, namely; a daughter, this deponent, wife of John T Davis, and a son Isaac Pean, whose wife's name is Henova, adults; - a daughter Ruth Johnson, unmarried, and adult; - a daughter Rebecca, wife of Grafton Hrey, adults; and Grand children, Mary Pean and George Pean, children of Alexander Pean, deceased, who died before his mother said Mary Johnson, leaving Elizabeth A Pean, as his widow surviving him. Said Mary and George Pean are infants under twenty one years of age.
