This Deed made this 15th day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty-three by us, Jacob Snyder & Mahala his wife Witnesseth that in consideration of Eight hundred and twenty three dollars & thirty two cents, we the said Jacob & Mahala Snyder do grant to Robert Wesley Nelson the following described parcel of land lying in Frederick County Maryland, being part of a tract, called "Mother's Care", and included within the following lines, viz: Beginning at a stone standing at the end of the eleventh line of the whole tract and running thence North Eighty degrees West One hundred two & eight tenths perches to a stone at the of the fourth line of the part of said Land sold to Jacob Anderson & with said line reversed South seven degrees West fifty six perches to a stone thence South Seventy nine & a half degrees East Seventy two perches to land heretofore sold
