The object of this suit is to procure a decree for the sale of the Real estate of which Sarah Wise, late of Frederick County, deceased, was in her life time seized and possessed, situated in Frederick County and which was conveyed to her by one Lewis O. Wise by deed dated March 23 1857 and recorded in Lib. E. S. No. 9, folio 391, one of the Land Records of Frederick County.

The Bill charges that the said Sarah Wise, deceased, was in her lifetime indebted unto the Complainant in the sum of One hundred Dollars for sundry matters and things properly chargeable in account, and unto sundry other persons in various sums of money; that being so indebted, she, on or about the 19th day of April A. D. 1881, departed this life, intestate, and leaving no personal property but leaving the real estate described in the bill of Complaint; and leaving as her heirs, at law the following children: William P. Wise and Susan his wife, Henry C. Wise and Alice his wife, Josephus H. Wise and Susan his wife, Elmira R. Wise; Amanda E., who married Jacob Knapp Jr., Samuel M. Wise and Georgianna his wife, and the following children of a deceased son, viz: Elewre Wise, who married Joseph Smith, Florence Wise and Charles Wise, all of whom are adults and residents of the State of Maryland except Samuel M. Wise and Georgianna his wife who being adults, are non-residents of the State of Maryland.

It is therefore ordered by this Court, on this 19th day of July, A. D. 1881, that the Complainant cause a copy of this order, together with the object and substance of this Bill to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County once a week for four successive weeks before the first day of September 1881, giving notice to the non-resident defendants in said Bill, and warning them and each of them to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor, on or before the 12th day of December 1881 to show cause if any they or either of them have why a decree shall not pass as prayed.
