Complaint

The Bill of Abraham Storer respectfully represents, that heretofore, on or about the first day of February in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy-two, or certain Samuel Stambaugh of Frederick County, agreed with your Complainant to purchase from him a certain piece of real estate situated in Frederick County described in a deed from Frederick White to your Complainant dated on the twenty third day of March, in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy-one, and duly recorded in the Land Records of Frederick County, in Liber P. No. No. 6 folio 455 &c, one of said Records, a certified copy whereof is herewith filed as part hereof marked Exhibit No. 1, which real estate comprises One hundred and thirty acres of land more or less, and also certain other real estate situated in said County containing twenty-three and three fourths acres of Land, more or less described in the proceedings in No. 3623 Equity in your Honorable Court, a certified copy whereof is herewith filed as part hereof, marked Exhibit No. 2, whereby the title of your Complainant fully appears, at and for the sum of two thousand two hundred dollars, your Complainant to give possession to said Samuel Stambaugh of all of said Real estate and to convey the same to him, and the said Samuel Stambaugh and Eliza Stambaugh his wife to pay the said sum of two thousand two hundred dollars as herein after set forth, and for the purpose of securing the same, to execute and deliver to your Complainant a Mortgage &c, upon all of said Real estate for said sum of two thousand two hundred dollars, payable as follows, two hundred dollars on the first day of October in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy-two, with interest from the first day of April Eighteen hundred and seventy-two, the remaining two thousand dollars payable in five
