May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainant the writ of Subpoena against the said George Miller of Frederick County, and against John W. Baruhart of Carroll County, and against Alfred W. Baruhart, Ellen Warman and Warman her husband Grace Walterkefer and Walterkefer her husband, and Harry Jones of Baltimore City State of Maryland, Commanding them to appear in this Court on some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed thereon.
