Miller signed her name to the same and the said George Miller made his mark to the same in your presence and is the signature Asst. Norris to said note in your hand writing. State fully all your knowledge herein.
- 4 Look at the paper now shown you marked Exhibit No. 1, state whether the said Ann R. Miller signed her name to the same and the said George Miller made his mark to the same in your presence, and is the signature A. J. Norris as witness to said paper writing in your hand writing. State fully all your knowledge herein.
