This deed this Eighth day of May in the year Eighteen hundred and Seventy-eight by George A. Miller and Ann R. Miller his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that for the consideration of Six hundred Dollars, the said George A. Miller and Ann R. Miller his wife do grant unto Elizabeth A. Miller, wife of Martin S. Miller a part of a tract of land called "Messuers Content" situate and lying in Frederick County aforesaid. Beginning to include the same at a small Horn bush, on the East side of Emmittsburg Rail Road and at the end of 33 7/8 perches on the 14th line, thence with and bounded on outlines thereof as bounded 1. North 7 1/2 degrees East 47 1/2 perches 2. South 17 1/2 degrees East 26 perches 3. South 13 1/2 degrees West 60 perches, 4. South 2 1/2 degrees West 28 perches, thence leaving the outlines and by dividing lines now made 5. South 88 1/2 degrees West 35 1/4 perches ending East of said Rail Road thence along the Eastern side of said Rail Road 6. South 1 1/2 East 22 perches, thence with a straight line along Eastern side of said Rail Road to the first beginning, Containing Twenty-eight Acres one Rod and twenty-seven perches of land, more or less, in fee simple.
