At the request of J. A. J. Zimmerman the following deed was recorded January 25th 1858.

This deed made this 19th day of January, A. D. Eighteen hundred and fifty eight by Daniel Geddrick & Mary Jane Elizabeth Geddrick his wife, Witnesses, that in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars, the said Daniel Geddrick and wife do grant unto John A. J. Zimmerman, a certain piece or parcel of Land, being part of a Tract of Land called "The Reserve" on part of Chestnut Hill being part of that tract of Land, conveyed by J. A. J. Zimmerman by deed bearing date 1st day of January 1856 to said Daniel Geddrick for Ten and One half acres, Beginning for the Outlines of the part here intended to be conveyed at the end of 9 1/2 perches on the third line, at a stone planted on the West side of the County Road passing on the East side then with said third line N 10 deg 37 in per. to a stone on the dividing line between said Geddrick & Philip Shankles, then with said dividing line N 42 deg 21 1/2 per to a stone then S 20 deg W with the dividing line between said Geddrick & Shelton within Eight Perches of the end thereof, then with a straight line to the beginning containing Eight Acres & two Rods. Witness our hands and seals.
