This deed made this 28th day of July A. D. Eighteen hundred and fifty eight by Phillip Shankle and Elizabeth Shankle his wife, Witnesses, that in consideration of One hundred and seventy seven dollars and fifty cents the said Phillip Shankle and his wife do grant unto J. A. J. Zimmerman, a certain piece of Land being part of a tract of Land conveyed to said Shankle by O'Neal & Markle as part of a Tract of Land called "Rocky Hill," commencing for the outlines thereof on the dividing line between said Shankle and J. A. J. Zimmerman, at a stone planted on the East side of the County Road passing through and running with said dividing line S 44 1/2 degs E 19.9 per to a stone, then with the outline N. 40 degs E 27 1/2 per to a stone thence N 43 degs 31 2 per to a stone planted on the East side of said County Road, thence S 32 degs 37 per to a stone, then with a straight line to the place of beginning, containing four acres One and thirty perches

This deed made this 12th day of November in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred and eighty nine, by Lewis H. Stull and Anna Stull his wife, Witnesses that in consideration of the sum of seventy five dollars, we, the said Lewis H. Stull and Anna Stull both of Frederick County State of Maryland, do grant bargain and sell unto John A. Zimmerman a certain piece or parcel of Land designated as Lot No. 4 it being part of a Tract of Land which was conveyed to the late Jacob Stull, by Jacob Markell, by deed bearing date the 13th of December Eighteen hundred and forty six and beginning for the outlines thereof, at the end of 27 feet on the fifth line of the whole tract, conveyed by Jacob Markell to Jacob Stull, and running with it South 44 East 34 1/2 per. to a stone at the end of said line, then with the given line of the whole tract South 44 West 3 6 per to the end of the third line of Lot No. 1, thence North 44 West 3 11 per to the corner
