This deed made this 19th day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty four by Jacob Stall and Eve C. Stall his wife of Frederick County And in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth, that in consideration of seventy five dollars current money, the said Jacob Stall and wife do grant bargain and sell unto John A. J. Zimmerman a piece or parcel of Land lying and being in the County & State aforesaid, and being a part returned of a tract of land conveyed by Jacob Marshall to the said Jacob Stall by deed dated on the 18th day of December 1846 and recorded in Liber W. B. L. No 3, folio 534 & 535 one of the Land Records of Frederick County, and being part of the whole tract, called "Rocky Hill," and beginning for the part here intended to be conveyed at the end of the twelfth line 10 perches Nor 55° East at a stone planted with 13 notches being the South East Corner of Lot No 23 called "The Reserve, or part of Chestnut Hill," and conveyed by O. A. Albaugh to John A. J. Zimmerman and running Nor 8° East 35 1/2th perches to a stake, at the end of the dividing line between John Shankle & the said J. A. J. Zimmerman, then South 42° West 27 1/2th perches to a stone planted on the boundary line of Chestnut Hill, & being also the corner of the dividing line between Jas. Stall & J. A. J. Zimmerman, and from thence to the place of beginning South 41° E 20 per, containing One acre and a half & thirty perches more or less. Witness our hands and seals.
