At the execution of the annexed Commission issued out of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, and directed to John E. R. Wood, and Clayton O. Keady, Commissioners therein named, and empowering them or either of them to examine Evidence in a Cause depending in said Court between Adam H. Eyler Complainant and Emiline A. Bowser, Adam Bowser, her husband; William H. Bowser and Margaret Bowser his wife Defendants; I Clayton O. Keady, one of the Commissioners named in said Commission having met at my office in Frederick City, Maryland, on the seventeenth day of April A. D. 1882, pursuant to previous notice thereof given, and in the absence of John E. R. Wood Commissioner, did then and there proceed to take the following testimony, to wit: \_\_\_\_\_

Testimony.

Adam H. Eyler, a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Complainant, being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Commissioner and herewith returned, deposes and says, To the

1st Int. State your name, age and residence?

1st Ans. My name is Adam H. Eyler; I reside in Frederick County, Maryland and am 56 years of age.

2d Int. Do you know the parties to this suit? If yes; give their names, ages and residences, and state whether all are living?

2d Ans. I know the parties to this suit. I am the Complainant. The Defendants Emiline A. Bowser and Adam Bowser her husband are both adults and reside in Frederick County. The Defendants William H. Bowser and Margaret Bowser his wife are both adults, and reside in Washington County, Maryland. The said William H. Bowser is the son of Emiline and Adam Bowser. They are all living.

3d Int. Look at "Exhibit No. 2," to this Bill of Complaint, and state whether it fully describes the land purchased by you from John C. Eyler. If yes, where is said real estate situated?

3d Ans. I look at said "Exhibit No. 2". It does describe the land purchased by me of John C. Eyler. The real estate is situated in Hawne District, Frederick County, Maryland.

4th Int. State whether or not you ever sold the land described in "Exhibit No. 2" to Emiline A. Bowser, and William H. Bowser. If yes; when, and look at "Exhibit No. 1," to this Bill of Complaint, and state whether it contains the terms of said sale.

4th Ans. I did sell the said Land to Emiline A. Bowser, and William H. Bowser; it was on March 22<sup>nd</sup> 1873. Said Exhibit No. 1, does contain the terms of said sale.
