This deed made this seventh day of February, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty seven, by Micha Shivers (widow) of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that in consideration of six hundred and twenty five dollars, current money (or its equivalent) the said Micha Shivers doth grant unto John N. Spargo of the said County and State, all of that lot or parcel of ground situated in the village of New London, in Frederick County aforesaid, and being on the East side of the Public Road leading from Liberty Town to New Market, together with all the buildings and appurtenances thereunto belonging, which is described as follows, the same being part of a Tract of land called "Redurvey or Drummine", it being the Lot of ground which was conveyed to Cornelius Shivers (husband of the aforesaid Micha Shivers) and to the said Micha Shivers by a certain Francis Lickle and Sarah Lickle his wife by deed dated the third day of October A. D. 1855, and recorded in Liber P. G. E. No. 1 Folio 181 & 182 of the Land Records of Frederick County. And, as reference there being had will more fully appear. Beginning for the land now intended to be conveyed at a stone formerly planted in the middle of the main road, leading from New Market, to Liberty Town, it being nearly opposite the stone house formerly belonging to a certain William Hobbs, afterwards Nathan Maynard Sen: & now owned by P. J. Hall, and running thence with a line, recorded to a lot of land formerly belonging to a certain Mahlon Swenley (since deceased) 1. South sixty nine degrees East twelve perches and nine twentieths of a perch to a stone formerly planted, 2. South five degrees East One and one half perches, 3. South seventy nine and three quarters degrees West six perches and nine tenths of a perch, 4. North sixty two degrees West six perches to the middle of the main road, then with the middle of said main road to the place of beginning, in fee simple.
