3d Int: Look at "Exhibit A." - Do you know for what purpose it was given and were you present at the execution thereof?

3d Ans. - I look at said "Exhibit A," I know the purpose for which it was given. It was given to secure a debt of seventy-five dollars due from Grandison Galloway, therein named to Christian H. Eckestein. I was present at the execution of said Mortgage and saw Grandison Galloway make his marks thereon, and execute the same before Worthington R. 5th Int: - Look at the signature of W. R. Johnson J. P. to the Certificate of Acknowledgment. State whether it is the genuine signature of W. R. Johnson and whether he was, at the time, a Justice of the Peace for Frederick County, Maryland.

5th Ans. - I look as directed. It is the genuine signature of W. R. Johnson and he was, at that time, a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland in and for Frederick County.

6th Int. - State whether or not said Grandison Galloway made his appearance as provided in said Mortgage, and had you an opportunity to know?

6th Ans. - He did not to my knowledge, and I had opportunity to know, being at the time Deputy Sheriff of Frederick County.

7th Int. - (Waived as to this witness.)

Christian H. Eckestein, a Witness of lawful age and residence on the part of the Complainant, being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Commissioner by the Complainant and herewith returned, deposes and says, to the,

1st Int. - Do you know the parties to this suit; If yes, how long have you known them?

1st Ans. - I know them, and know Grandison Galloway in his life time, but he is now dead, having died some four or five months ago. His wife is also dead.

2d Int. - Where do you reside, and what is your business?

2d Ans. - In Frederick City. I am an Attorney at Law.

3d Int. - Look at "Exhibit A." - Do you know for what purpose it was given and were you present at the execution thereof?

3d Ans. - I look at "Exhibit A." It was given to secure the payment of a debt of \$75.00 from the Mortgage to the Mortgagee therein named. I was present at the execution thereof.

4th Int. - Is said "Exhibit A." the original Mortgage? If yes, is the signature of W. R. Johnson as the witness to Grandison Galloway's mark the genuine signature of W. R. Johnson?

5th Int. - Look at the signature of W. R. Johnson, J. P., to the Certificate of acknowledgment, and state whether that is the genuine signature of W. R.
