Your Complainant further states that the said Sarah A. N. Easterday the wife of said Joseph Easterday, on the 14th day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, executed her last Will and Testament in the presence of three witnesses, and by the provisions thereof devised to her children Rachel Ann Easterday, Sarah V. Easterday, Jacob F. Marion Easterday and Joanna Easterday the farm on which she at that time resided, containing sixty-six and a fourth acres as by reference to the Recd. will more fully appear. And the said Joseph Easterday the husband of the said Sarah A. N. Easterday, on the same date under his hand and seal, concurred in the provisions of the aforesaid last Will and Testament all of which will fully appear by reference to a certified copy of said Will herewith exhibited, marked Exhibit No. 2.

Your Complainant further charges that the said Sarah A. N. Easterday died in the year 1859, or in the year 1860 and that she failed to execute the will aforesaid, in conformity with the provisions of the Acts of Assembly in such cases made and provided, and that the same is invalid, and passed no title to the Real Estate mentioned and described in Exhibit No. 1 herewith filed.

And your Complainant further charges that the said Sarah A. N. Easterday having failed to execute the said Will as required by Law, in the execution of Wills of Married women - she died intestate, and that the Real Estate mentioned in said Exhibit No. 1, descended to her children, as tenants in common, subject to the right of her husband Joseph Easterday therein, as tenant by Courtesy - And that at the time of her death she left her husband Joseph Easterday, her surviving, and the following children viz -

- 1st - Rachel Ann Easterday, who married John S. Easterday, and died since her mother leaving the following children viz:
- 1st John Ernest Easterday -
 - Sarah Easterday -
 - Ellen Easterday -

All of whom are infants under the age of twenty one years, and reside with their father John S. Easterday at Charlestown Jefferson County, West Virginia and to whom the interest of their mother in said land descended.

- 2 - Sarah Virginia Easterday, who married Fayette Sander and died since her mother, leaving one child viz -

Fayette Shagle Sander
An infant under the age of twenty one years, and who resides with his father, Fayette Sander, at Charlestown, Jefferson County, West Virginia, and to whom the interest of his mother in said land descended.
