I, Sarah A. St. Easterday of Frederick County, State of Maryland, do make, Ordain publish, and declare this to be my last Will and Testament, in manner <sup>and form</sup> following, that is to say— First after my debts funeral charges are paid, I devise, and bequeath, as follows.

Item. First I give and bequeath unto my dear children, Rachel Ann Easterday, Sarah Virginia Easterday, Jacob J. Marion Easterday, and Joanna Easterday my infant daughter— my servants Henry aged seventy, Kholilah aged seventy George aged thirty, and Samuel aged twelve years. The above described slaves to be hired out, or to remain with my beloved husband Joseph Easterday, to assist in the support and maintenance of my children, should he in his judgment be disposed to keep said servants with him for said purpose, I not to be sold or divided until my youngest daughter, Joanna Easterday, shall arrive at majority.

Item. Second I will and bequeath to my children Rachael Ann Easterday, Sarah V. Easterday, Jacob J. Marion Easterday, and Joanna Easterday, my personal effects of every sort, kind, or description, embracing my stock to wit: Hogs & Cattle, my horse doctor— farming implements, household and kitchen furniture, Wheat & rye growing in the ground & any every sort or kind of personal property whatever now in my possession. The within described personal property to remain in the hands of my Executor herein after named for the support & maintenance of my beloved children, or if in the judgment of my Executor he should deem it best to sell and dispose of said personal property, he is at liberty to do so, for the use and benefit of said children & for other purpose.

Item. Third. I will and bequeath to my beloved children Rachael Ann Easterday, Sarah V. Easterday, Jacob J. Marion Easterday & Joanna Easterday my infant daughter all moneys that may be due me in the hands of Mr. George W. Larum, my trustee, or from any other person or persons whatever, said funds to pass into the hands of my Executor hereinafter named, and to be invested by him for the benefit of my children.

Item. Fourth. I give and devise unto my children Rachael Ann Easterday
