The Petition and Report of Sales of Samuel A. Brown & William P. Maulsby Jr. respectfully shows to your Honor that they were on the 15th day of August, 1882, appointed a certain Edward Solomon of Frederick County Trustee for the benefit of his creditors under and by a certain deed filed herewith as Exhibit "A" which with all other Exhibits herewith filed is prayed to be taken and considered as part hereof - That your Petitioners accepted said Trust and took possession of the property mentioned in said deed having given Bond with approved security for the faithful discharge of their Trust; That your Trustees having been authorized by said deed then proceeded to sell at Public Sale on Saturday the 2^d day of September, 1882, on the premises in Frederick City all the Real and personal property conveyed by said deed to your Petitioners, having first given notice by advertisement and hand bills of said sale and sold the Real Estate in said deed mentioned to a certain Richard P. Hagan and Charles M. Hagan, at and for the sum of \$3325 payable One third Cash on ratification of sale and balance in 6 or 12 months to be secured with notes and security satisfactory to Trustees. (Your Petitioners further report that they sold all the personal property except a wagon which was not at hand at and for the sum of \$1619.89; out of which sum the sum of \$100. exempt by law from execution & mentioned in the deed of Trust has been paid for benefit of Edward Solomon by his request; That the balance of said sum of \$1619.89 except the sum of \$75.50 has been paid in notes or cash the said sale of personalty having been on terms of all sums of \$100 and under Cash on day of sale, all sums above \$10 to be secured by notes of purchaser with security satisfactory to Trustees; That said sum of \$75.50 was for a wagon sold a certain Edward Adams, who not being financially responsible and offering to return & refusing to keep said wagon at the price he had bid for the same viz, \$75.50 Your Trustees induced him to keep the same, agreed to accept of 70 - for the same, for the same which sum he has not yet paid although he has agreed to pay the same.
