It is therefore ordered by the Circuit Court for Frederick County State of Maryland as a Court of Equity, and by authority of the Judges thereof that the said Martha Hagan be and she is hereby allowed in lieu of her said dower right in said Real Estate One eighth part of one equal tenth part of the net proceeds of the sale of said real estate that being deemed a just and equitable allowance therefor due regard being had to her age, health, and the provisions of the Law, in relation thereto and the Auditor is hereby directed in stating his accounts in this case to make her allowance accordingly.
