Steele of Carroll County, State of Maryland, Attorney in fact, for the heirs of Joshua Hall, late of Howard County, deceased, said donor of Attorney, dated and executed on the 26th day of October 1875. - Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred Dollars, Current money, the said James H. Steele, Attorney in fact, do grant, bargain, and sell, unto Abraham Mikesell of Frederick County, and State aforesaid, his heirs and assigns in fee simple, all those several parts of Tracts or parcels of Land lying contiguous, and being situated, partly in Howard County, and part ly in Carroll County, and State aforesaid, to wit: part of a Tract called "The Additional Release", and all that tract called "Wayman's Discovery Secured", and more fully described in deed from Jesse Hall and Corilla Hall, his wife to Joshua Hall, and recorded in Liber 91. 91. 91.
