4th Int. - Did he leave a widow and children living? if yes, state their names, ages, and residences and if any married the names of their husbands, and wives?

4th Ans. - He left a widow and four (4) children surviving him, as follows:  
His widow P. Rebecca Zimmerman, aged about 55 years.

(1) A daughter, Clara Zimmerman, who is married and over twenty-one years of age.

(2) A daughter Florence, married to David L. Hedges, both of whom are over 21 years of age.

A (3) son, Harry S. Zimmerman, who is a little under 21 years of age.

(4) A son Spencer S. Zimmerman who is under 21 years of age. All these parties live in Frederick County, Maryland.

5th Int. - State whether you have paid and satisfied the \$800<sup>00</sup> in Bonds on which you were security, principal and interest, and whether Mr Zimmerman's heirs and representatives are willing for you to have a deed for the farm?

5th Ans. - I have paid and satisfied the note in Bonds and Mr Zimmerman's heirs are willing for me to have a deed for the farm.

6th Int. - Will it be for the interest and advantage of said heirs that you have a deed and whether that is carrying out the agreement you understood?

6th Ans. - It will be to their interest and advantage for me to have a deed for the farm, and it would be carrying out the agreement entered into between Mr. Oliver J. Zimmerman, myself and my son, Abraham Meikesell.

Mrs. Caroline Rebecca Zimmerman, a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Complainant, being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Commissioner by the Counsel for the Complainants and herewith returned, deposes and says, to the

1st Int. - State your name, age and place of residence?

1st Ans. - My name is P. Rebecca Zimmerman, my age 55 years and I reside in Frederick County.

2d Int. - Look at the paper now shown you, marked "Exhibit No. 1," and state what it is, and if a deed, from whom it was obtained and all the circumstances, understanding and agreement under which it was made?

2d Ans. - I look at the paper marked "Exhibit No. 1". It is a deed from John J. Jamison, Trustee of Abraham Meikesell to Oliver J. Zimmerman and George Meikesell. Mr. George Meikesell and Oliver J. Zimmerman were on a note of \$800<sup>00</sup> in the Central National Bank of Frederick for Abraham Meikesell, and they had a mortgage on his farm to secure themselves and when the farm was sold by John J. Jamison, Abraham Meikesell's Trustee, they bought the farm to secure themselves, on the understanding that when Abraham Meikesell paid the note, he Abraham Meikesell was to have a deed for the farm. Abraham Meikesell has been in possession of the farm and has paid the interest on the note, except \$48<sup>00</sup> which was paid by George Meikesell and Oliver J. Zimmerman.

3d Int. - State whether Oliver J. Zimmerman is living or dead and if dead when and where did he die?

3d Ans. - He is dead. He died in Frederick County, in the month of May, 1852.
