This deed, made this twenty first day of April in the year Eight hundred and seventy-four, by us, Charles F. Wemmer and Lavinia Wemmer, his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of four thousand Dollars, to us paid by John L. Jordan Senr. of said County and State - and for and in consideration of a like sum of four thousand Dollars, to us paid by William Graham, also of said County and State. We the said Charles F. Wemmer, and Lavinia Wemmer, his wife, do grant unto the said John L. Jordan Senr. and unto the said William Graham each one undivided third part of and interest in and to the following described property, to wit: All that Lot or portion of ground, situate lying and being in the Town of Berlin, in the County of Frederick, and State of Maryland, known & designated on the Plat of said Town as Lot number four, with the buildings and improvements thereon which the said Charles F. Wemmer, obtained from Edward Hynes and wife by deed, dated the fifth day of April, in the year 1868, and recorded in the Land Records of Frederick County, aforesaid, in Liber C. M. No. 2, folio 10, as by reference thereto will appear. Also, all other Lot or parcel of Land situate and lying in said Town of Berlin, and designated on the Plat thereof as Lot number thirty-two (No. 32) together with the well property, and improvements thereon, and all the rights, privileges and advantages thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining - being the same Lot No. 32, which the said Charles F. Wemmer obtained from Samuel C. Washington, and wife, by deed, dated the fifth day of July, in the year 1855, and recorded in said Land Records, in Liber E. S.
