This deed, made this twenty first day of August, in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy nine by one Milton G. Verue, Justice, Witnesseth, Whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting in Equity passed on the 27th day of October, A. D. 1877, in the case of S. Holland Singapore & others vs. Adam Jackson Singapore & Chas. Emory Singapore being No. 4187, in the Equity docket of said County, the said Milton G. Verue appointed Justice to sell the land, decreed to be sold, and have sold the same to Mortimer S. Wanner who has fully paid the purchase money therefor and whereas by a further order of said court in above cause passed on the 16th day of August A. D. 1879, John S. Jordan Sr. William Graham and Chas. Fenton Wanner, were substituted as purchasers of the said Real Estate, in the place of the said Mortimer S. Wanner, and therefore, in consideration of the premises, I the said Milton G. Verue Justice, do grant unto John S. Jordan Sr. William Graham and Chas. Fenton Wanner all that real estate situated in the town of Berlin in said County, of which William Singapore late of Frederick County deceased, did die seized, and possessed being more particularly described in four deeds of Conveyance to William Singapore from Robt. Rome Esqrs, William Hager, A. J. Mc Miller Esqrs, and James Kennedy, recorded respectively in Liber St. R. L. No. 7 folio 437 Liber C. W. No. 5, folio 675, Liber C. No. No. 4 folio 398, Land Records of Frederick County,
