This Mortgage, made this twenty-fifth day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty five by us Jacob Eckwode and Catharine B. his wife, Witnesses. That whereas the said Jacob Eckwode by his note or obligation duly executed, bearing date with these presents, stands bound unto Reuben Fleming for the sum of four hundred and seventy six dollars payable on or before the twenty-fifth day of March, in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty six, with interest from the date thereof, as by the said note or obligation may more fully appear, the said Jacob Eckwode and Catharine B. his wife do grant unto Reuben Fleming two Lots of ground situate on the Main Street in the North side, in the town of Emmittsburg in Frederick County & State of Maryland, and designated on the plat of said town by numbers one and two. Provided that if the said Jacob Eckwode shall pay to the said Reuben Fleming the said note or obligation, with the interest thereon at the time specified herein then this Mortgage shall be void. The said Jacob Eckwode and Catharine B. his wife, covenant that in default of payment the said Reuben Fleming may enter.
