Gelwicks and Mary his wife, they being known to us to be the persons who are named, and described as and professing to be the parties to the foregoing deed or Indenture and do severally acknowledge the said Indenture or instrument of writing to be their respective Act and deeds, and the said Mary Gelwicks having signed and sealed said indenture before us out of the presence and hearing of her husband, and the said Mary Gelwicks being by us examined out of the presence and hearing of her said husband whether she doth execute and acknowledge the same freely, and voluntarily and without being induced to do so by fear or threats of ill usage by her husband or by fear of his displeasure, declareth and saith, that she doth.
