2d Int. - Did you know Andrew Coffman, late of Frederick County, if so, is he living or dead, and if dead, when and where did he die?

2d Ans. - I knew him. He is dead. He died on his farm in Mechanicstown District, Frederick County, Maryland, on or about the fifteenth day of October 1881.

3rd Int. - Did said Andrew Coffman die testate or intestate?

3rd Ans. - He left no will.

4th Int. - Did said Andrew Coffman die leaving any personal estate, and if yea, have Letters of Administration been granted upon the same, and if so to whom; and is such personal estate sufficient to pay all the debts of said Andrew Coffman died? State fully all you know herein?

4th Ans. - He died leaving personal estate. Letters of Administration have been granted to his son James C. Coffman, and I am acting as his agent. The personal estate is not sufficient to pay all his debts. His debts will be about \$1500.00, to the best of my knowledge and information. He left personal property to the amount of about \$1100.00.

5th Int. - Did said Andrew Coffman die seized and possessed of any real estate and if so, describe the same, and give its quantity and value. Look at "Exhibit No. 4," now shown you, and state whether or not the Real Estate therein described is that of which the said Andrew Coffman died seized and possessed?

5th Ans. - He died seized and possessed of Real Estate situated in Mechanicstown District, Frederick County, Maryland, consisting of a farm of about 114 Acres, and worth about \$3,000.00. I look at "Exhibit No. 4." It does describe the Real Estate of which the said Andrew Coffman died seized and possessed.

6th Int. - Did said Andrew Coffman die leaving a widow surviving him, and did he leave any children or other heirs at Law, if yea, give their names, ages, and places of residence, and if any are married, give the names of their husbands or wives?

6th Ans. - He left no widow surviving. He left the following children as his only heirs at Law, viz:

(1) James C. Coffman, married to Susan, his wife, both of whom are adults over 21 years of age, and reside in Frederick County, Maryland.

(2) William C. Coffman, an unmarried adult over 21 years of age, who resides in Frederick County, Maryland.

(3) Elizabeth M. Coffman, an unmarried adult over 21 years of age, who resides in Frederick County, Maryland.

(4) Charles Edward Coffman, an infant under 21 years of age, who resides in Frederick County, Maryland.
