2nd The \$2000, hereinbefore willed to my niece Lucia R. J. Whitmore.
3rd I give and bequeath to my brother John S. Whitmore \$1500 (Fifteen hundred) after which the remainder of the proceeds as aforesaid shall constitute a general fund for distribution to the children of my brothers and sisters respectively. This fund shall be divided into 5 (Five) equal distributive shares or parts, which shall be disposed of as follows, viz: One of these equal shares or parts shall be divided between ^{the children} of my brother William in an equal manner, each of them receiving an equal part of the said distributive share.

One of these distributive shares or parts as aforesaid shall be divided in like manner between the children of my brother Nicholas

One of said shares in like manner shall be divided between the children of my sister Mary Ann (who married John Hedges)

One of said shares or parts in like manner shall be divided between the children of my sister Ann Rebecca (who married John Schaeffer)

And the remaining one share shall in like manner be divided between the children of my sister Phoebe Ann (who married William S. Martz.)

Nevertheless it is my further will and desire that should my brother John have any direct issue or heir at the time of the distribution takes place as hereinbefore provided then the proceeds of my estate as aforesaid shall be divided into 6 (Six) equal parts instead of Five as heretofore directed and such child or children of my said brother John shall be entitled to one sixth part or one distributive share to be divided in like manner as the others, and each of the before named shares shall be a sixth instead of a fifth which shall then be divided as hereinbefore named.

And further I hereby name and appoint my beloved wife Ann C. Whitmore to be the sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament, and hereby revoke any former will by me made, affirming this, and this only.

In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal, and publish and decree this to be my Last will and Testament in presence of the Witnesses named below this 15th day of May, A. D. 1878.
