Hedges, who is an adult, non-resident of the State of Maryland, and resides in the State of Missouri, John Hedges, Mary Jane Hedges, Annie P. Hedges and Ellie R. Hedges all of whom are adults residing in Frederick County, that the children of Ann Rebecca Schaeffer are Nicholas Schaeffer who is an adult residing in Frederick County, and Charles Schaeffer, Annie R. Schaeffer and James C. Schaeffer who are infants under the age of twenty-one years and reside in Frederick County, that the children of Throckmorth Mark are Randolph N. Martz, Charles Martz, Jennie P. Martz, John W. Martz, Harvey Martz and George Martz all of whom are infants under the age of twenty-one years and reside in Frederick County. The Bill prays for an account of the personal estate, the application of the personalty to the payment of the debts so far as the same will go and for a sale of sufficient Real estate to supply the deficiency and for general relief.
