At the request of Moses Boone the following deed was recorded March 24th 1862  
This deed made this twenty fourth day of July in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty two by William H. Stout and Marietta C. Stout his wife of Frederick County, and State of Maryland, Witnesses, that in consideration of two hundred and twenty dollars, the said William H. Stout and his wife Marietta C. Stout, doth grant unto Moses Boone of said County and State, part of Lot number one hundred and twenty six laid down in the plan of Frederick Town, on Kalenchar's Alley, the said Moses Boone to have the one half of said house, to be divided by the partition therein and running through to the end of said Lot sixty two feet, and that part of said Lot adjoining the Lot purchased by Thomas Cornech, it being the one half of the Lot (on the south side) purchased by the said William H. Stout of James M. Sherry, Executor of W. Weber deceased, by reference to said deed dated February the twentieth Eighteen hundred and fifty two the whole with more fully appears. Witness our respective hands and seals.
