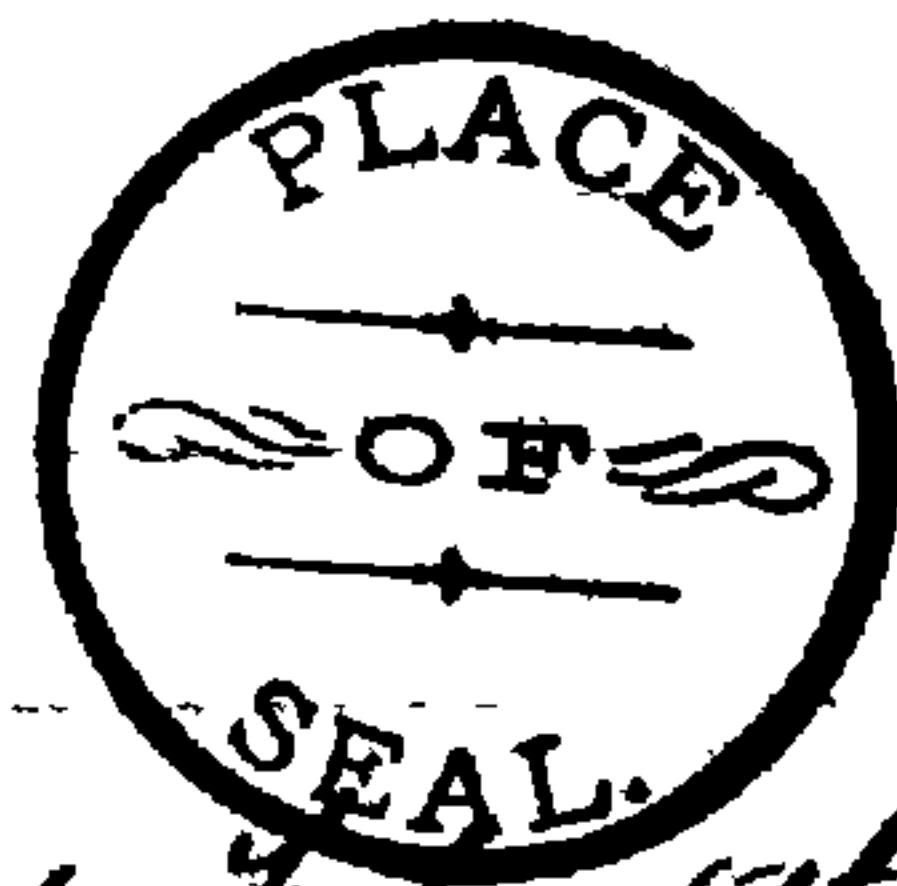

Miller Executor of Matthew Butcher late of Frederick County, Maryland deceased under a power contained in the last Will and Testament of said deceased, in consideration of the sum of three hundred and twenty dollars have bargained and sold to John Wilcoxon of said County and State all that piece or parcel of ground with the buildings thereon situated lying & being on All Saints Street in the City of Frederick and which the said Matthew Butcher obtained in his lifetime from George W. Ent, by deed dated March 2d, 1847 and recorded in Liber W. B. L. No. 4, folio 632, &c. one of the Land Records of Frederick County, reference thereto had will, more fully and large appear.
