

## No. 4868 Equity.

2d Int.— Do you know the parties to this Cause? If yes, state how long you have known them, and where do they reside?

2d Ans.— I know all the parties to this Cause, except the children of Thomas and Anna Mary Getzendanner, the Grand-children of John Wilcoxon. I have known the parties whom I am acquainted for some years, and all the parties to the cause live in Frederick County except several of the Grand-Children.

3d Int.— Did you know John Wilcoxon, late of Frederick County? If yes, is he living or dead? If dead, when and where did he die, and did he die testate or intestate?

3d Ans.— I knew said John Wilcoxon. He is dead. He died in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland in the Early part of February (about the 2<sup>nd</sup> I think) 1883, I understand he died intestate.

4th Int.— Did the said John Wilcoxon leave a widow surviving him? If yes, is she yet living? State her name, age and residence?

4th Ans.— He left a widow surviving him and she is yet living. Her name is Martha E. Wilcoxon; her age about 44 years, and she resides in Frederick County, Maryland.

5th Int.— Did the said John Wilcoxon leave any children and grand-children surviving him? if yes, state their names, ages, and residence and if any are married, the names of their husbands or wives?

5th Ans.— He did. He left:

A son, Rufus Wilcoxon, whose wife's name is Annie.

A daughter, Fanny, whose husband's name is Philip L. Metshen.

A daughter, Maggie, whose husband's name is William M. Wynn Jr.

A daughter, Laura Jane whose husband's name is Frank Nijou.

A son, Charles Wilcoxon.

A daughter, Tempie E. Wilcoxon.

A daughter, Hattie R. Wilcoxon, and

A son Harry E. Wilcoxon, all of which children are over twenty one years of age, except the three (3) last named (Tempie E., Hattie R., and Harry E.) who are infants under twenty one years of age, and all of the above named children and their husbands and wives live in Frederick County, Maryland. He had another daughter Anna Mary, who was married to Thomas Getzendanner but who died some years ago leaving children whose names I do not know. The persons named and referred to in this answer are all the children and heirs at Law of said John Wilcoxon.
