This deed made this ninth day of November in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, by John W. Shaw and Sarah M. Shaw his wife and Warner J. Grimes of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesses that for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and eighty six Dollars and seventy five cents, The John M. Shaw and Sarah M. Shaw his wife and Warner J. Grimes do grant unto Abraham A. Black, all the following described lot of Land situate at the North end of Creagerstown. Beginning at the North East Corner of the Lot now held by Augustus Short and running back with his Lot South 82 West 12 7/8 perches thence again with said Lot South 19 Degrees East 11 7/8 perches thence South 82 Degrees West 10 perches to Stone North 19 1/2 degrees West 36 perches North 6 degrees West 30 perches to the Public Road, and with it South 48 1/2 degrees East 42 7/8 perches South 7 degrees East 21 5/8 perches the place of beginning Containing seven Acres and twenty seven perches of Land in full.
