Ans. We were married in Westminster, Carroll County, Maryland on the 13th of February, 1862.

2nd Sub. State all the places you resided at prior to your marriage and the length of time you resided at each place, designating the year or years, respectively, in which you resided in each place, and state your occupation whilst in those places?

Ans. I was born near Eck's Mill, in Carroll County, Maryland, and was there, I suppose, ten or twelve years - from 1833, to about 1845; we moved from there over close to Alloway's Creek, Carroll County, Maryland, and resided there, up to 1848; from there we moved to Jacob Kernell's, and I think, we only lived there one year; we moved from there to Jacob Shenk's place, near Taneytown, Carroll County, Maryland; I think we stayed there two or three years; I'm not certain, but I think it was two years; from there we moved to Hank Road, near the Baptist Meeting House; we lived there eight years; I worked among the neighbors for a short time when I first went there; I was twenty years old in June, 1853, but in April 1853 I left home and went to learn carpentering and bridge building with John N. Taylor & Bros., near Emmittsburg, Frederick County, Maryland; I remained there with them I think two years and nine months then I hired one year (one year) to the "Georgetown College", at White Marsh, Prince George's County, Maryland; then I went on my own lunk in the same neighborhood; I remained there, until December, 1861; then I came to where I live now - where my father lived then; while I was in Prince George's County, I was carpentering; from that time until I was married, I worked a little at anything that came to hand (until I was married,) my father lived on what is called the "Wagon Tract," which was afterwards deeded to me.
