Ans. I did not.

To redirect interrogatories filed with the Commissioner by the Complainants, and herewith returned, the said James A. Cundorff deposed & says:

1st R. D. Sub. When did you first go to Judge Maulaby's office, and for what purpose?

Ans. I don't recollect just exactly what time I went there; it was in the month of July of the same year in which "Exhibit No. 7," was executed, to state to him the facts which I have already herein before stated?

2nd R. D. Sub. For what purpose, did you go to state the facts to Judge Maulaby?

Ans. Because the property belonged to my wife, and the deeds were to me and in my name.

3rd R. D. Sub. Was, or was not, the object of your visit to have Judge Maulaby to put the title out of your name, and into your wife's name?

Ans. It was, because it belonged to her, was bought for her, and was paid for her out of her money.

4th R. D. Sub. Who went with you to Judge Maulaby on that occasion?

Ans. Nobody but myself.

5th R. D. Sub. Had your wife know you were going there, and for what purpose you were going?

Ans. Yes, Sir.

6th R. D. Sub. Before going to Judge Maulaby, had you, or not, agreed with your wife to convey the property to her?

Ans. She told me the property belonged to her, and she wanted a deed for the property; before I went down to Judge Maulaby, I had agreed and promised my wife, that I would execute a deed for the property to her.

7th R. D. Sub. Had you not, at the time you promised your wife, to convey her the property, tell her you would go to Judge Maulaby, and have him prepare the deed for it?

Ans. I did not.

8th R. D. Sub. What did you tell her you were going to Judge Maulaby for?

Ans. I don't recollect what I told her; I don't recollect anything about it any more.

9th R. D. Sub. (You have said you promised your wife, before going to Judge Maulaby, to convey the property to her; did you, or not, go to Judge Maulaby for the purpose of performing that promise?)

Ans. I did not go there for the purpose of performing the promise, until after I had consulted Judge Maulaby.
