9th. To the competency and admissibility of all, and each and every of the declarations and acts of said James A. Crudorff, out of her presence and hearing, given in evidence by complainants, on the ground that the same, and every thereof, are incompetent evidence against her in this cause.

10th. To the competency, and admissibility of each and every part of the evidence given by the complainants, because the same, and each part thereof, is incompetent and insufficient to impeach the title of this defendant, Mary E., under the deed mentioned in the bill of Complaint, and filed as an exhibit therewith.

11th. To the competency and admissibility of the several copies of judgments filed by the Complainants with the Commissioner, and returned with said Commissioner, because the same are incompetent to affect this defendant's rights in said cause.

Wherefore, the Defendant, Mary E. Crudorff, prays that the said testimony hereinbefore mentioned and referred to, and each part thereof, may be rejected, and not considered by the Court at the hearing of said cause.
