I hereby Certify that on this Eleventh day of September 1883 before the subscribed a Justice of the Peace of the said State in and for said County personally appeared William P. Maulsby and made oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that he was present at the sale made by G. S. Lory and F. J. Nelson Esquires Trustees of the real estate in the Cause by Eliza Crouse and others vs James A. Orendorff and Mary C. Orendorff being the real estate in the proceedings mentioned in the Cause No. 4411 in the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting in Equity - that said Trustees offered at public sale in one body all said real estate except a Wood Lot containing about Ten acres - that thereupon this affiant informed said Trustees that as Attorney and Counsel for said Mary C. Orendorff he notified them that he objected to their selling any more of said real estate than might be necessary to pay the debts in the decree and proceedings in said Cause aforesaid, and the costs and expenses accrued in said Cause and under said decree - and that a good and sufficient bidder and purchaser was present, and would bid and pay the sum of Four thousand dollars for the two parcels of said real estate on which were erected and standing the Dwellinghouse and Barn and other buildings of said farm, One of which parcels contained between one and two acres, and the other something near fifty acres - that said parcels could be advantageously sold separate from the rest of said estate.
