The complainant in this cause by Frank C Norwood, his solicitor moves to amend the Bill filed therein as follows: Your complainant further showing unto your Honors that the real estate of which the said Reuben Stevens did seized and possessed consisted of the following parcels or tracts of land all situate and lying in Frederick County Maryland first, a lot of two acres of land fully described in a deed (see Exhibit C) from Samuel Hoke to the said Stevens recorded in Liber C.M.
