

for Montgomery County, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of this Court adjudged, ordered and decreed, that the return of the Commissioners appointed to make partition of the real estate in the proceedings mentioned, and the partitions thereof by them made be, and the same is hereby, ratified and confirmed; and it is further adjudged, ordered and decreed, that the complainants, Charles W. Shrover and Thomas J. Shrover, having jointly elected to take the whole of the said real estate, and the remaining parties to this suit, having refused to elect to take any part thereof, that the said Charles W. Shrover and Thomas J. Shrover shall hold the said lands in common with each other, and not jointly or in common with the other parties to this suit, all of said lands being described in the return of the aforesaid Commissioners, and the plat accompanying the same.

And it is further ordered that this case be referred to the Auditor of this Court to state an account with the parties, and after deducting costs and expenses of this suit to make distribution of the clear proceeds among the several parties according to their respective interests which said report shall be returned to this Court for its further action, and upon the final ratification of said report, the said Charles W. Shrover and Thomas J. Shrover shall execute their bonds, with good and sufficient security, to be approved by the Clerk of this Court to the State of Maryland, conditioned for the payment to the several parties for the sums respectively audited to them in said report, said bonds payable respectively in one, two and three years from the ratification of said report, and to bear interest from the date of said election, and upon the payment of the whole of said bonds to the parties respectively, and all interest which has or may accrue on the several amounts thereof, the said Commissioners or a majority of them, shall convey the whole of said real estate by good and sufficient deed to the said Charles W. Shrover and Thomas J. Shrover.
