Petition for leave to amend bill.

Your petitioners pray leave to amend the original Bill inserting an allegation that the property cannot be divided among those interested and that it would be to the interest and advantage of all parties to sell it and divide the proceeds, or if can't be sold to be leased under the order of the Court.

Your petitioners also pray leave to amend by inserting the name of your petitioner J. E. R. Hood as a Complainant who was not a party to the original bill and the names of some infants born since the filing of Original bill as defendants to this the amended bill of Complaint so as give a perfect title and bind all the parties so being. And your petitioners will ever pray &c.

Court's order

The foregoing petition having been read and duly considered by the Court it is thereupon this twelfth day of April A.D. 1878 ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity and by the authority thereof that leave be and the same is hereby granted to amend the original bill in this case by making J. E. R. Hood a Complainant and making all children born since this bill was filed who have an interest in the real estate in this Cause parties defendants and by making the additional allegations in the body of the Original bill of Complaint as prayed in the petition

Amended Bill of Complaint

To the Honorable the Judges of the Sixth Judicial of the State of Maryland.

The Bill of Complaint of Charles H Shreve and Anna E Shreve his wife of Montgomery County in the State of Maryland and John E. R. Hood of Frederick County in the State of Maryland respectfully shows unto your Honorable Court that on the 3 day of April A.D. 1855 a certain Mary E Shreve late of the County and State aforesaid being possessed of valuable real and personal estate both in the State of Maryland and Virginia made and executed her last will and testament, and shortly after the execution of her aforesaid last will and testament the said Mary E Shreve died, leaving a husband Benjamin Shrove, and Daniel T Shrove, Benjamin F Shrove, Charles H Shrove, Thomas J Shrove, Mary E Shrove, Anna O Shrove, and Arthur B Shrove seven children surviving her.

That in September A.D. 1860 the said Benjamin Shrove the husband of the said Mary E Shrove also departed this life, and that on or about the 4th day of February A.D. 1861 the said Mary E Shrove daughter of the aforesaid testatrix died without issue

That the said testatrix by her said last will and testament willed and bequeathed to her
