To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a court of Equity.

The Petition of Francis J. Bartholow of Frederick County State of Maryland a pecuniary legatee, and also one of the distributees under the last will and testament of John Bartholow late of Frederick County deceased, respectfully shows to your Honors, that the said John Bartholow was in his life time seized and possessed of several parts of tracts and parcels of land, situate in New Market District Frederick County State of Maryland described in the deeds from Henry M. Elfesh to Jesse Wright & John Bartholow, & from Jesse Wright to John Bartholow and from John P. Wood and others to John Bartholow, and from Cornelius Gimes to Jesse Wright & John Bartholow, certified copies of which are herewith exhibited marked Exhibits Nos. 1, 2, 3 & 4. also all that part of a tract of land purchased of John Markell Peter Mantz and Nicholas Bringle by said John Bartholow, situate in the County & State aforesaid containing about 10 acres of land, and also certain other small tracts of land which have been in the possession of the said John Bartholow for more than twenty years, and for which no deeds can be found by your Petitioner. Your Petitioner further states that the said John Bartholow by his last will and testament dated on the 20th day of December 1870, and duly executed according to law to pass real estate among other devisees and bequest did give and bequeath to his wife Sarah A. the full amount of his property both real and personal which the law may allow her, and did also bequeath to your Petitioner the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars to be paid your Petitioner out of his personal or real estate, and the residue of his property after his wife's part and the legacy to your Petitioner is paid is to be divided equally between testator's three children, Francis J. Bartholow Mary A. Buckingham and John W. Bartholow, the share of the said Mary A. Buckingham to be held in trust by your Petitioner Francis J. Bartholow who is directed by the terms of said will to invest the distributive share bequeathed unto her the said Mary A. Buckingham and to pay unto her the income arising therefrom semi annually, and after her decease the principal sum shall be divided equally between her children as appears by reference to a certified copy of said will herewith exhibited marked Exhibit No 5. which together with all other exhibits hereinbefore produced your Petitioner
