1883 July 8th Received Stamp duty W B Tyeor. Clk.

This indenture made this 29th day of June one thousand Eight hundred and fifty between Catharine Rhodes of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part and Christina Barr of Washington County in said State of the other part, Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars current money of the United State by the said Christina Barr to her the said Catharine Rhodes in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which she doth hereby acknowledge the said Catharine Rhodes hath bargained and sold aliened & conveyed and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell, alien convey release convey and confirm unto the said Christina Barr her heirs and assigns all that part of a tract or parcel of land called "The Recovery on Maryland" lying and being in the County of Frederick aforesaid and contained within the following metes and bounds courses and distances to wit. Beginning for the same at a stone planted near a gate North East from Knysville (said stone being at the end of the 12th line of a deed from Henry Boteler to Catharine Rhodes bearing date the 21st day of December 1845 and recorded in Liber W B T. No L. folios 548 & 55 one of the Land Records of Frederick County) and running thence N by W 23 3/4th ps with the 12th line of said deed to a spring branch and thence with the meanderings of said branch the two following
