To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County Sitting as a Court of Equity
The Bill of Complaint of Sam^l Glisson of Frederick County who files this bill as well for himself as for all other creditors of Absalom Cline late of Frederick County dec^d who shall come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit respectfully shows unto your Honors that Absalom Cline late of said County died sometime about the first of April A. D. 1883, after having made and executed his last will and testament whereby he devised and bequeathed to Rachel R. Albaugh and Sarah E. Dorsey wife of Nimrod B. Dorsey "all of his property, real personal and mixed, of every sort, kind and description and wherever situated" and appointed Jasper Albaugh the Executor of said will; that said will was duly admitted to probate by the Orphans Court of Frederick County and letters testamentary granted thereon to said Jasper Albaugh, who has given bond and entered upon the execution of said will, all of which will appear by a certified copy of said will and exemplification of said letters filed herewith marked Exhibits Nos 1 & 2. and which with all other Exhibits herewith filed are prayed to be taken as part of this bill of Complaint as fully as if here inserted in words and figures; that said Absalom Cline was at the time of his death indebted to complainant by his promissory note dated the 31st day of March A. D. 1877 for one hundred and fifty dollars payable six months after date with interest from date, and which is now over due with interest from the first day of April A. D. 1881, a copy of which note is herewith filed marked Exhibit No 3; that said Absalom Cline was at the time of his death also indebted to your complainant by his certain other promissory note dated May 21st A. D. 1878 for one hundred dollars payable on demand with interest from date and which is now over due with interest from the 21st day of May A. D. 1881, a copy of which note is filed herewith as exhibit No 4. that said Absalom Cline was at the time of his death indebted to your complainant by his certain other promissory note dated the 1st day of April A. D. 1880 for One hundred dollars payable twelve months after date with interest from date, and which is now over due with interest from the 1st day of April 1881. a copy of which note is filed herewith as Exhibit No 5 And said Absalom Cline was at the time of his death further indebted to your Complainant upon open account in the sum of Eighteen dollars and forty seven cents a copy of which is herewith filed as Exhibit No 6. That said Absalom Cline died seized and possessed of certain personal estate described in an inventory returned by said Executor a copy of which is filed herewith marked Exhibit No 6. but the personal Estate of said Absalom Cline is insufficient to pay his debts; that said Absalom Cline died seized and possessed of an interest in fifty five acres, two oords and thirty eight perches of land more or less, situated in Frederick County, and which interest is as follows: George Cline, the father of said Absalom Cline died intestate in the month of February in the year 1873, seized
