2. Do you know the parties to this suit, and if yea, how long have you known them?
3. Did you know Absalom Cline late of Frederick's County, if yea is he living or dead and if dead, when and where did he die?
4. Did said Absalom Cline die testate or intestate?
5. Was said Absalom Cline, married or unmarried at the time of his death?
6. Do you know Rachel R. Albaugh and Sarah E. Dorsey, the legatees and devisees mentioned in said will, are they living or dead and if either of them is dead when and where did she die?
7. Did said Sarah E. Dorsey die leaving a husband now surviving her, and if yea give his name, age and place of residence and did she leave any children or other heirs at law, if yea give their names ages and places of residence?
8. Did said Absalom Cline die seized and possessed of any real Estate and if yea describe the same fully and particularly, State where the same is situated its quantity and Value State all you know with reference thereto?
9. Was the said Absalom Cline indebted to the Complainant at the time of his death and if yea, State fully how he was so indebted, the amount of such indebtedness and whether the same has ever been paid? State all you know with reference thereto?
10. Did said Absalom Cline leave any personal estate, and is the same sufficient for the payment of his debts? What did such personal property amount to? Look at the paper now shown you marked Exhibit No. b. and State whether or not the personal property therein described is that of which said Absalom Cline died seized and possessed, State fully all you know with reference thereto?
