At the request of Elizabeth C Hamilton the following Deed is recorded August 16th 1877.

This Deed made this 14th day of May in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and seventy seven by William R Walker and Mary A. C Walker his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of Ninety dollars, the said William R Walker and Mary A. C Walker his wife do grant unto Elizabeth C Hamilton wife of John Hamilton of the said County and State aforesaid in fee simple the following piece of land, part of a tract of land called Curalls Forest which was deeded to Mary A. C Walker wife of William R Walker, on the 4th December 1866. Beginning for the outlines of the piece now intended to be conveyed at a stake planted at the end of 19 7/10 ps on the 1st line of that lot of ground sold by Mary A. C Walker to William Bell and running thence with the second line reversed of the lot sold to William Borobia Co. N 60th W 10 2/10 ps to the center of the County Road and with it S 27 1/2th W 35 2/10 ps to the end of the 5th line of C. H. Wattermans lot and with his lot S 72 1/2th E 14 2/10 ps intersecting the 1st line of said Bells lot and with said line reversed N 25th E 32 1/2th ps to the beginning containing 2 1/2 acres & 12 ps.
