Mottet be and they are hereby relieved of the further execution of the trust reposed in them by the decree heretofore passed in this Cause and that John H Hamilton and George W Hamilton are hereby appointed trustees in their stead to sell the property therein mentioned in the mode and manner and upon the terms specified in said decree, but before proceeding to make sale they shall give bond in the same sum and in the same manner as required in said decree and shall give notice of sale in the manner required by said decree and report their proceedings as therein directed.
