The Petition of Margaret Shank and Henrietta E. Albaugh by Jeremiah Albaugh her husband and next friend respectfully shows:

1st That Mary A Saylor late of Frederick County and now deceased was at the time of her death indebted to your Petitioner Margaret Shank by her joint and several promissory note signed by herself and J.M. Newman for the sum of Two hundred dollars, dated the 6th day of April A.D. 1892 and payable twelve months after date with interest; and was also indebted to your Petitioner Henrietta E. Albaugh by her note signed by herself and J.M. Newman for three hundred dollars, dated Sept 16th 1878 payable one year after date with interest from date and upon which interest was paid to Sept 16th 1892 and also one hundred dollars paid Sept 16th 1890 and fifty dollars paid Sept 16th 1892 as will appear by said notes filed herewith marked Exhibits "M.S." and "H.E.A." respectively

That the personal estate of said Mary A Saylor was wholly insufficient for the payment of her debts and has been fully administered in the Orphans Court as will appear by a certified copy of the 1st & final account of David A Baker Adm^r settled in said Orphans Court, and a copy of the list of debts filed herewith and marked respectively Exhibits P & Q
