At the Request of John Henry Beall the following deed is recorded June 10th 1872. This deed made this ninth day of June in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy nine by us Alexander O Beall and Caroline Beall his wife of Frederick County Md. Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars, we the said Alexander O Beall and Caroline his wife do grant unto John Henry Beall of the County and State aforesaid the following described parcel of land lying and being in the Pleasant District being part of a tract of land called "Discovery Resurveyed". Beginning at the the end of the second line of A O Bealls land and near by the Bucking gate, and running with the third line North thirty eight and a half degrees West sixteen perches then leaving the outlines South twenty three degrees West thirteen and two tenths per or until it intersects the 2 line aforesaid then with a line North Eighty nine and a half degrees East fourteen and six tenths per to the beginning. Containing ninety square perches of land more or less. But should the said John Henry Beall die without leaving a child or children or descendant of a child or children living at the time of his death, then and in that event the aforesaid property conveyed is to go back to the said A O Beall or his heirs and representatives in law the said land conveyed is part of the same land conveyed to A O Beall by Geo W Buckley Trustee by deed dated October 4th A. D. 1854 and recorded in Liber C. S. No 9. folios 157 & 158 one of the Land Records of Frederick County. Also a right of way on the South side of said A O Bealls land to the public road.
