That your Honors will pass an order directing the Auditor in stating an account in the foregoing case to allow your Petitioner the amount of said Costs and funeral expenses out of the proceeds of sale after allowing the amount of the Mortgage claims, Commissions, Costs, and all proper expenses allowable under said Mortgage

2. That your Petitioner may have all such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require &c.
