The Bill of Complaint of Charles E. Manly and Florence J. Manly his wife and Georgie Grove an infant under twenty one years of age by Margaret J. Grove her guardian and next friend all of Marion County in the State of West Virginia, respectfully represents and charges that a certain George Grove of Frederick County Maryland, in the month of December in the year eighteen hundred and eighty one departed this life at the County aforesaid intestate, seized and possessed of certain real estate, consisting of a farm containing two hundred and forty four and one eighth acres of land more or less lying partly in Frederick and partly in Carroll Counties Maryland about eighty acres of which lies in Frederick County and the remainder in Carroll County which land was conveyed to the said George Grove by deed from Robert's Dorsey trustee and a certified copy of which deed as recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County is herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 1. to this Bill of Complaint, which Exhibit with all other Exhibits by these Complainants herewith filed they pray may be considered as a part hereof, as fully as if herein inserted in words and figures
These Complainants further represent and charge that the said George Grove left surviving him a widow named May Grove, who is about eighty years of age and who is still living and the following named Children and grand Children who are his heirs at Law to wit.

1. A son Samuel E. Grove, who has a wife living named Ruth Grove
 - 2nd A son, William P. Grove, who has a wife living named Julia Grove
 - 3rd A Daughter Ann S. Grove and
 - 4th The following named Grand Children, Florence J. Manly whose husband's name is Charles E. Manly, Wilhelmina Tobin, whose husband's name is David H. Tobin and Georgie E. Grove who are the Children and heirs at law of Martin J. Grove a son of the said George Grove deceased and who died intestate in the year eighteen hundred and sixty seven leaving a wife named Mary Ann J. Grove and the above named Children surviving him.
- These Complainants further represent and charge that all the above named Children and grand Children with their husbands and wives as set forth are at present living, that Samuel E. Grove and his wife Ruth Grove reside in Carroll County, Maryland, that the widow May Grove and Ann S. Grove reside in Frederick County Maryland; that William P. Grove and Julia Grove are now residents of the State of Maryland and do not reside therein but reside in the District of Columbia; that your Complainants reside in the State of West Virginia and that David H. Tobin and Wilhelmina Tobin his wife reside in the State
